
Gathering COST: €695 = approximately \$1,200 Australian per person Registration covers hotel/convent accommodation, meals, entrance to all venues and participants' materials.

Travel to and from Turin, and insurance are registrants' responsibility.


Turin in Italy is also called "Turino". Ask Sandro how it is pronounced correctly.
